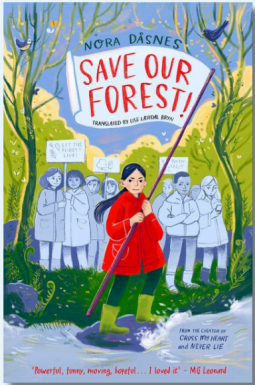


Save Our Forest!

TIME TO TALK

- 1 What are some of the environmental issues highlighted in the story?
- 2 What is climate change? What are some of the ways we can help reduce climate change?
- 3 Bao leads the fight to save the forest, what qualities do you think you need to become a leader?
- 4 How do Bao and her friends try to save the forest? Do you think they went about it the right way? What would you do differently?
- 5 The characters face many challenges, give examples of how friendship and teamwork help the characters to achieve their goal.
- 6 What is activism? Why do you think it's important for young people to become involved in activism? Can you name any activists?
- 7 What role do you think governments should play in protecting the environment? Are there any policies that you think should be changed or implemented by the government?
- 8 The story is based in Norway, what do you think the most pressing environmental issues are in your area?
- 9 What do you think the world will look like in the future if current environmental trends continue?
- 10 How do you think we can inspire people to care for the environment?
