## Primary book subscriptions terms and conditions 03.07.23

- 1. Book subscriptions include a 20% discount on the books' total RRP as standard. Schools will pay £750 per year and the value of books received will be £937 RRP.
- 2. Schools will receive approximately 36 books per term (£312 RRP); this number may vary slightly according to the publishing available.
- 3. Payment of the yearly subscription charge entitles schools to three separate book deliveries across three terms.
- 4. When a book subscription is ordered through our website or via a member of our team, Peters will generate an invoice to be paid by the school account, which will be sent to the school using the contact details provided at the point of order.
- 5. New customers who have not purchased from Peters before will need to create an account on our website and their account must be approved in order to subscribe.
- 6. Subscribing schools must opt-in and pay up front for at least one full year (three school terms). After one year, your subscription will automatically roll over until the next academic year unless cancellation is requested. We will send a new invoice at the beginning of Year 2.
- 7. We are unable to credit school accounts or issue a refund after payment has been made for a full year subscription. Schools are free to cancel before payment at the beginning of the year made by contacting us at the point of invoice.
- 8. Schools that opt to subscribe within the first half of a given term will receive a box of books for that term, up until the half-term break. Schools subscribing after the half-term break will receive their first box from the beginning of the following term.
- 9. Books provided will be new and up-to-date titles published within the previous three-month period. We will only send high-quality, age-appropriate titles selected by Peters' qualified teacher and librarian team.
- 10. Book selections will incorporate fiction and non-fiction with an approximate 70:30 ratio. This ratio may vary slightly with each delivery depending on the new publishing available.
- 11. As far as possible we will aim to provide a diverse and inclusive selection of books each term, to reflect the cultural backgrounds of all children, dependent on the new publishing available.
- 12. Each book included in your termly selections will be a single copy only. To ensure schools receive a wide range of new publishing, we will not send multiple copies of titles.
- 13. Books provided will be selected by the Peters' team as per the criteria named above. Schools may not request specific titles to be included with their selection.

- 14. Subscription books cannot be swapped or returned by the school. We are unable to provide refunds on individual titles.
- 15. Books within your subscription will be supplied un-serviced (without jackets, labels or barcodes).
- 16. Books will be sent with free delivery within mainland UK. Book subscription orders sent to schools outside of the UK will be subject to a delivery charge (dependent on local freight/shipping charges). We will advise schools of this delivery charge ahead of shipping the order.
- 17. With each delivery schools will also receive a selection of free, age-appropriate book-themed materials such as posters and bookmarks, supplied to Peters by UK publishers. The quantity of free materials sent will be dependent on availability at the time of posting. Materials will be generic and may or may not relate to books featured in your termly selection.
