Take on the role of a character from a Greek myth.

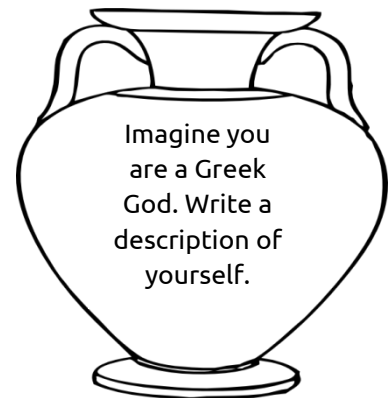
Answer questions in role
