The Cats' mats.

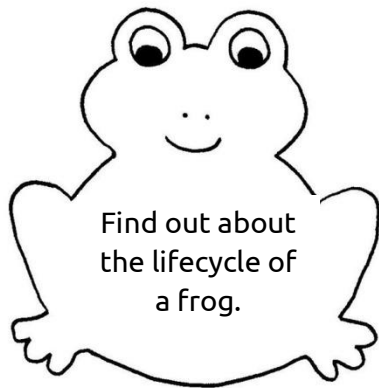
**YEAR 6**

Writing in the active and passive tense:

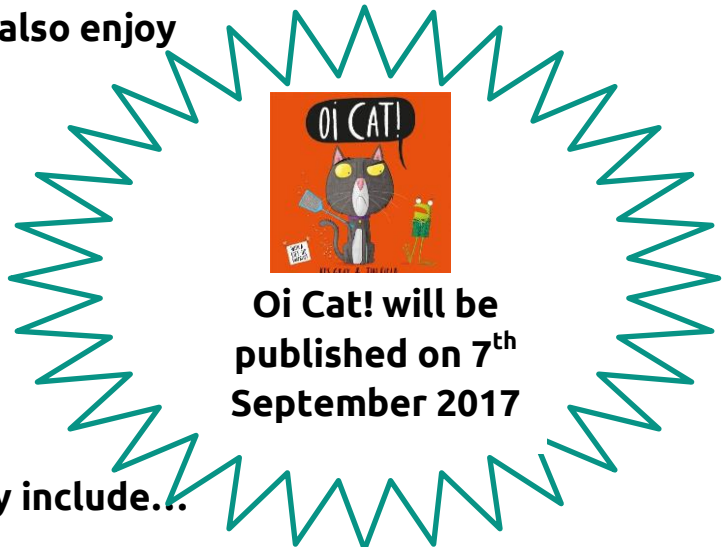
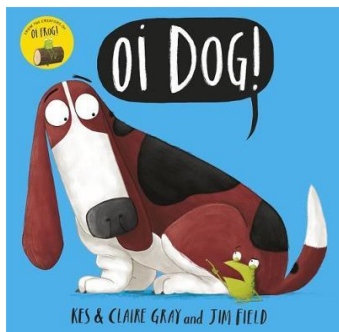

The ribbons were tied by the gibbons.

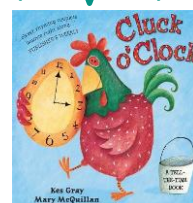
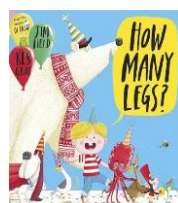
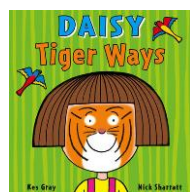
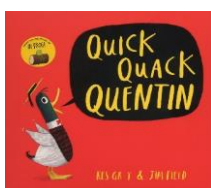
