

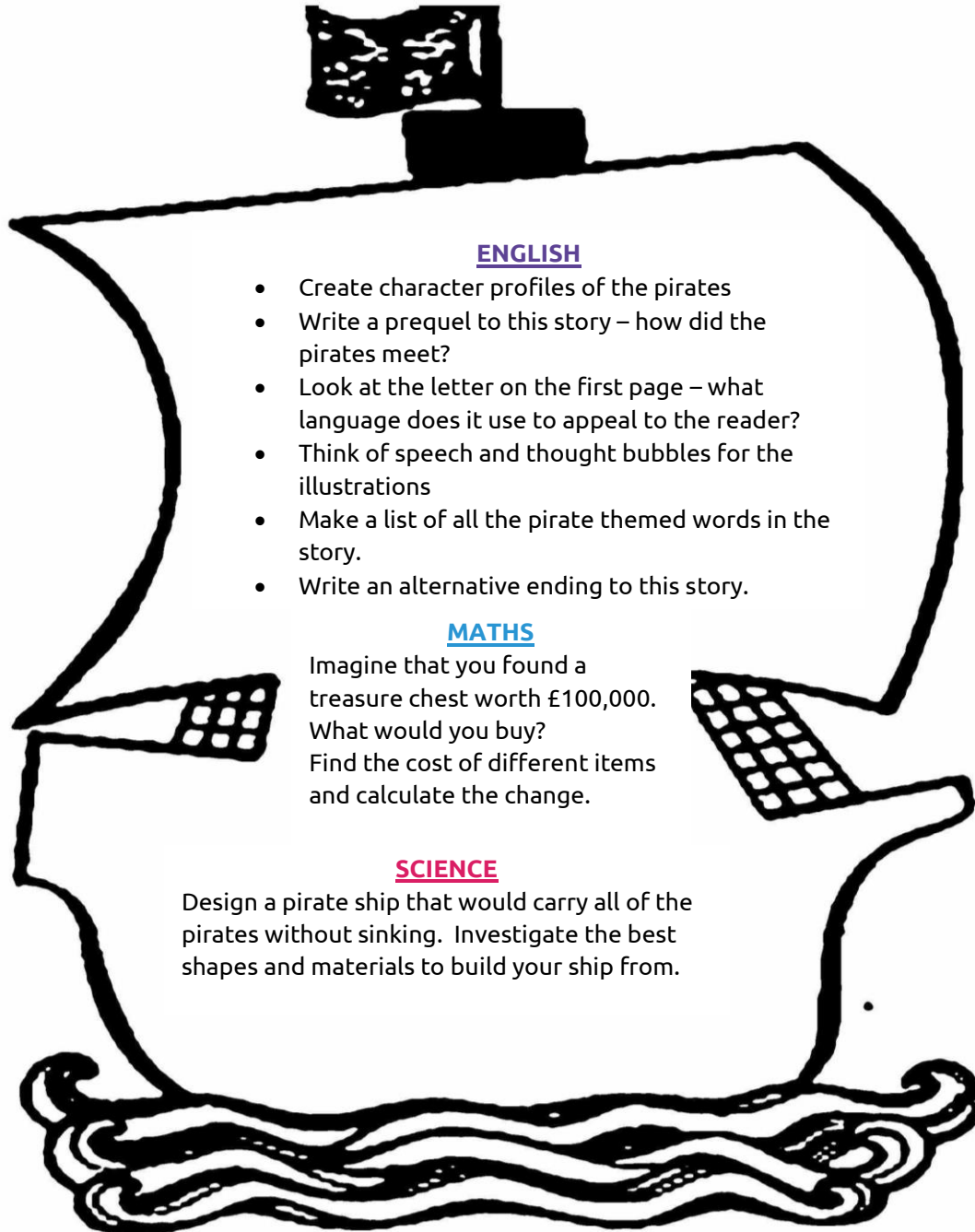


TITLE: The pirate-cruncher

Paint portraits of Captain Purplebeard and his crew

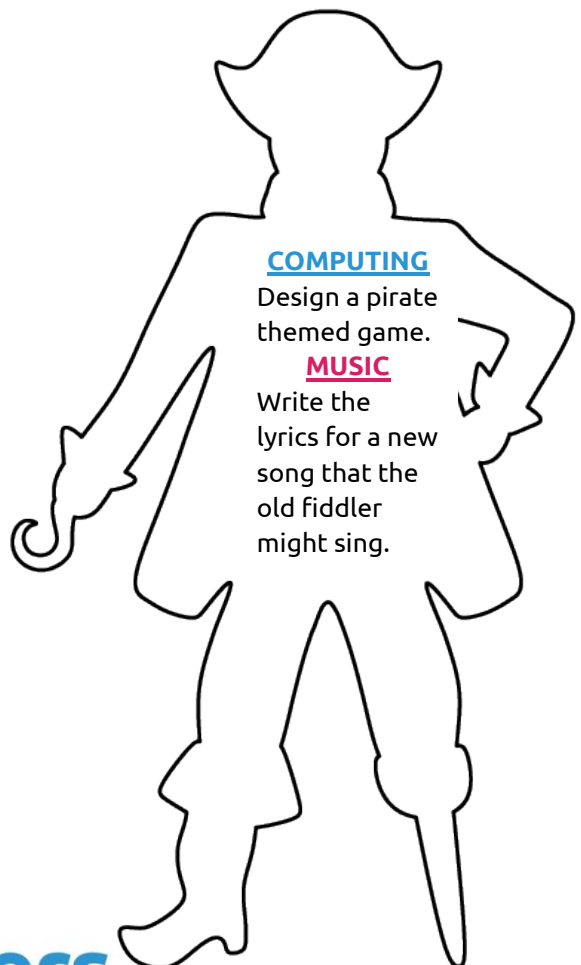
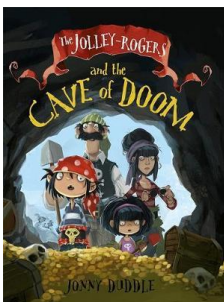
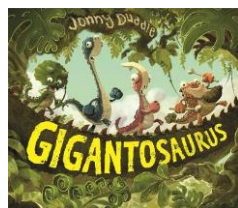
GEOGRAPHY
